2009–10 Talent-Based Scholarship Application
for Currently Enrolled Students

Currently enrolled Music majors who are not receiving a Department of Music Talent-Based Scholarship may apply for a renewable Department scholarship during the Winter Term. All applications will be reviewed by the Faculty Committee on Scholarships and Awards, and students will be notified no later than April 30, 2009. Students applying for a new scholarship must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Minimum over-all GPA of 3.00; minimum Music GPA of 3.00
- Must be officially enrolled in a music BA, BMus, Graduate Certificate, MA, or MMus concentration
- Must be making good academic progress (Undergraduates should have completed a minimum average of 14 credits per term during prior enrollment; Graduates should have completed a minimum average of 7–9 credits per term)
- Must have completed two full terms of study at WSU at the end of Winter, 2009
- Students should be involved and contributing members of the Department

Complete applications must include one complete copy of this form, with all signatures, and a student-generated transcript of all WSU coursework.
